Styles taught include danzon, son, son montuno and cha-cha-cha; modern Cuban salsa evolved from and is based on these classic and timeless dance styles. Emphasis on timing, footwork, body movement and position, and dancing with the clave.

The first portion of the class is a listening workshop, covering understanding and appreciating the structure of the music, how to hear and respond as a dancer to musical cues and more.
